2022 Koosah Pinot Noir

Sitting atop the Eola-Amity Hills is one of the highest and steepest vineyards in the Willamette Valley. Koosah Vineyard was established by the Chambers Family in 2016, following their vision to push viticultural boundaries with data-driven Biodynamic farming and permaculture design. Although Koosah sold in 2022 to Louis Jadot, our relationship with the vineyard will continue well into the future. The high elevation and exposure to coastal winds creates beautiful, complex fruit.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2022 vintage started with a wet and cold spring, delaying bud break. The spring continued with a record-breaking frost in mid-April, decreasing yields across the Valley and created uneven ripening. Once summer started we had a consistently warm growing season and Oregon experienced the hottest October on record. Warm days with breezy conditions through the fall months, produced thicker than average skins and clean fruit. Our harvest started early October, and resulted in texturally rich and ageable wines.

TASTING NOTES

Koosah Vineyard produces wines that are fresh and concentrated with dark fruits. Truly a thought-provoking wine to age with the best of them. Notes of fresh plum, leather hide, and dried rose with a rustic texture.
